We help schools create & maintain a safe, supportive instructional environment in which all students are treated with dignity and respect.

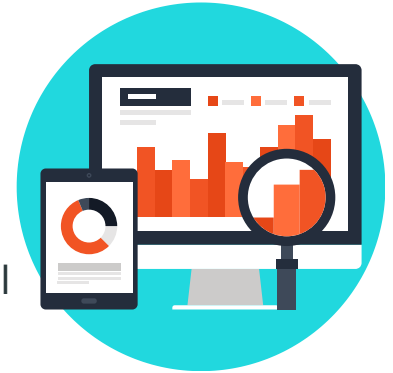
### Our Vision

## BIS IN FCPS

Under the Supervision of the Program Manager, we provide comprehensive intervention support for Pre-K to 12 students receiving general and special education services in:

- Behavioral support & intervention services to their schools
- Facilitating the design & implementation of behavioral prevention/intervention strategies



Each pyramid has an assigned Behavior Intervention Teacher (BIT), approximately 8 Schools

## OUR SUPPORT IN NUMBERS



During the 2019–2020 SY, BIS provided 44 training opportunities for staff in the area of Executive Functioning Skills

During August and September of 2020, BITs provided 113 supports for students with Autism Spectrum Disorder accessing the General Education Curriculum.
